WATER LABORATORY ALLIANCE (WLA) WORKSHOP: Water Sector Emergency Response Planning

The Delaware Public Health Laboratory and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) are hosting a workshop designed for the Water Sector and laboratories to enhance their preparedness to respond to an all-hazard water contamination incident that requires analytical support.

WORKSHOP OBJECTIVE:

Participating organizations will develop a roadmap that will guide the revision (or creation) of their emergency response plans that includes analytical support considerations.

ROADMAP DEVELOPMENT WILL BE ACCOMPLISHED THROUGH:

- Gathering and reviewing plans and documents in advance of the workshop.
- Learning about EPA water-security resources through participation in an interactive tabletop exercise with a water contamination incident scenario.
- Networking and learning from fellow colleagues in the Water Sector through small-group breakout sessions, individual brainstorming sessions and facilitated large-group discussions.
